This seasonal position offers a unique opportunity to engage with the natural beauty and artistic heritage of the Leighton Art Centre while inspiring creativity and environmental stewardship in our young visitors.

School Year Hours (September – Mid-June): Flexible, as needed based on school field trip bookings

Summer Hours (Mid-June - August): Full Time Hours - Monday to Friday 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM

School Year Responsibilities:

- Lead Field Trips: Conduct guided field trips for school groups on the 80 acres of the Leighton Art Centre, combining elements of nature exploration, museum visits, and hands-on art activities.
- Nature Walks: Lead engaging and informative nature walks, helping students connect with the surrounding environment, emphasizing its cultural and ecological significance.
- Museum Visits: Facilitate visits to our art museum, providing context and insight into the Leighton family's artistic legacy and the Centre's exhibitions.
- Hands-On Art Activities: Lead interactive art workshops that encourage creativity and expression, using various mediums and techniques.
- Flexibility: Enjoy a flexible schedule during the school year, accommodating both your academic commitments and the Centre's field trip schedule.

Summer Responsibilities:
