



MATERIAL PREPARATION: ART & NATURE PROGRAMS

Join us on Fridays as we prepare materials for Leighton Art Centre's signature Art & Nature Programs. You'll be making a tangible difference in our community by ensuring Art & Nature Program participants have the chance to explore their creativity through hands on experiences in art and nature.

When & where?

- Every Friday between 10 AM to 4 PM in the Sprung Studio.
- We're looking for individuals who can commit to a weekly volunteer shift. Many of the material preparations require specific instructions and training, therefore you can make the greatest impact with an ongoing volunteer commitment.

What are the tasks?

- Assist with prepping materials and supplies needed for programming. This includes cutting/ bending willow, warping willow looms, building wire blocks, cutting/ portioning clay, cutting yarn, placing stickers on sketchbooks, cutting paper.
- Help with inventory management: track usage and replenish supplies as needed.

Are there any other requirements?

- You must be at least 14 years old.
- You'll need your own transportation to and from the Leighton Art Centre.
- Some tasks include repetitive motion and significant grip strength.

What are the benefits of volunteering?

- You'll have the opportunity to make a meaningful impact by supporting our educational vision and mission at the Leighton Art Centre
- Develop teamwork, communication, and project management skills in a collaborative environment.
- Work with a community of like-minded individuals dedicated to fostering the arts, nature, and history.
