Wild at Heart!

Get ready for an adventure into Alberta's wild side! Campers will explore the world of Alberta's canines and felines—like wolves, coyotes, cougars, and bobcats through art projects, games, and outdoor exploration. Learn about these predators, their habitats, and their role in the ecosystem. Whether you're team canine or feline, this camp promises fun, friendships, and inspiration for a paws-itively unforgettable time!

Flower Power!

Join us for a week of fun celebrating Alberta's plants native and invasive species alike! Explore our 80-acre wild landscape, create "flower power art," and discover the traditional meanings and medicinal uses of local flora. Campers will enjoy flower-inspired projects like natural plant inks, painting, and printmaking. It's a week of hands-on learning, nature connection, and blooming creativity for budding environmentalists and artists!

Monster Mash!

Get ready for a thrilling week of artistic fun! Campers will explore mythical creatures, legendary beasts, and imaginative monsters through storytelling, art projects, and outdoor adventures including a look at local legend Bigfoot. They'll experiment with various art techniques like drawing, painting, printmaking, and tie-dye. North Star Navigators!

This week will celebrate Northern Canada discover all of the beauty, culture, and natural wonders of Canada's north! - What does a week at camp look like: During the week your child attends, they will be immersed in Art & Nature! They will spend the week as an artist, working with a variety of media (ie. printmaking, acrylic, clay etc.) and exploring the beautiful rural landscape! Our summer camp is a fun, arts immersion program designed to build your child's talents and skills as an artist.
- Who can attend Summer camp: Our summer camp is open to children and youth 6-14 years old. Campers must turn 6 years old by July 1, 2025 to attend (no exceptions).
- Can my child be in the same group as their friend? You are welcome to send us a request for your child to be in the same group as a friend. We cannot guarantee that we will be able to place them together as group placement decisions are at the discretion of the Camp Director.
- Can siblings be in the same group: We do our best to accommodate requests to have siblings in the same group but we do encourage children to go in their own separate groups according to age. Lunch is a great time for friends/siblings to be together and our groups are never too far away from one another if there is ever a concern. The interests of all our campers, as well as parent requests, will be carefully taken into consideration at all times.
- Summer camp hours: Camp begins at 9:30 am and ends at 3:30 pm, Monday to Friday. If your child needs to miss a day(s) of camp they are signed up for, please call (403-931-3636) or e-mail our office at education@leightoncentre.org. We are unable to offer a discount for any missed days. Drop off will be available no earlier than 9:20 am and your child must be picked up no later than 3:30 pm, with no child care available before or after these times.
- **Summer camp location:** The Leighton Art Centre is approximately 20 minutes southwest of Calgary, at 282027 144 Street West, Foothills AB. More information is available on our website.
- **Transportation to camp:** Busing is included for summer camp participants. See our bus information included in this package or on our website. It's very important that you have your child ready at the bus stop for sign-in at least 5 minutes before the actual pick-up time so our bus can stay on schedule!
- What if I miss meeting the bus to pick up my child: Your child will stay on the bus and ride to the next stop. Call our bus cell number that is provided in the 'welcome to camp' email to arrange to meet the bus. If you miss the bus in the morning, please drive your child to the next stop on the route (time permitting) OR directly to Leighton Art Centre.

Cancellation & Transfer Policy

If you need to cancel your registration, we will issue a full refund provided you cancel at least 4-weeks prior to the start of the booked camp. No refunds are issued after 30 days prior to camp start date.

Transfer of your child's registration to another week of camp can be discussed at the discretion of the Education Director.

A \$25 transfer fee (per child, per week) will apply to any child transferring to a different week of camp. We are unable to pro-rate the cost of camp if your child needs to miss any day(s).

Behaviour Policy

Summer camp attendees and their families/quardians are expected to show respect to others, Leighton Art Centre and its natural surroundings. Children and parents/guardians are expected to follow the rules set out by Leighton Art Centre. Please note, the administration of the Leighton Art Centre reserves the right to remove a child from camp for behaviour that is not in keeping with the above expectations or if the child is unable to cope with the challenges of camp. We will be strictly enforcing our 3-strike policy.

• What should my child wear to camp: Camp is messy and the weather can change quickly and unfortunately, this year we are not able to lend out extra clothing. Children should wear play clothes that they can get messy in. Please do not send them in anything nice because it most likely won't stay clean for long! Leighton Art Centre takes no responsibility for damaged clothing. Please ensure that your child has all the layers and possible changes of clothes they will need for the day.

What should my child bring to summer camp:

- Lunch, snacks and plenty of fluids!
- Apply sunscreen and bug spray before camp and then pack them so they can be reapplied later in the day.
- Send your child with a hat, rain gear, and dress your child in layers. They will be outside in nature each day (sometimes in the rain) and often the morning is cool and the afternoon heats up!
- We are a rural centre. Your child will be hiking on unpaved pathways and must wear appropriate footwear and clothing (no flip flops or crocs).
- We are a nut aware site; please avoid sending your child with any food that contains nuts. We thank you in advance for helping keep all our campers safe.
- Can my child bring electronics/cell phones to summer camp: We ask that your child does not bring any electronics or cell phones as they may not be used at camp. Leighton Art Centre is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- What if my child loses something: Please label <u>ALL</u> items sent to camp (clothing, lunch bags, water bottles etc.) and make a note of the personal items your child brings to camp. If you notice something missing, encourage your child to look through our Lost & Found (located in the Education Centre Office). Items in the Lost & Found are kept until Labour Day.
- Can I visit my child at summer camp to see and share in their activities? The best day to visit is Friday afternoon on the last day of camp as we hold a drop-in Open House and Art Show for families anytime between 3:00 3:30 pm on Fridays. This is an optional art show, but a great opportunity to share in the joy of your child's learning and discoveries! After Parents have toured the camp art exhibit and museum, they can gather their children and head for home after an action and fun filled week. Please note that staff supervision is only available until 3:30 pm and children must be picked up prior to this time. If you're unable to attend the Friday Open House and Art Show, the bus will run as usual and we will provide your child with alternate activities and some special attention after 3:00 pm.

Camp Hours and Parking Info

Summer camp begins each day at 9:30 am and ends at 3:30 pm.

Leighton Art Centre is unable to offer pre or post camp childcare

Please try not to arrive before 9:20 am or after 3:30 pm.

Please do not park on the main road for safety reasons.



- Can I visit Leighton Art Centre when I drop my child off or before I pick them up? Leighton Art Centre is open 10:00 am 4:00 pm, Tuesday Sunday during the summer months, and you are welcome to walk the property after drop-off on camp days. If you you need to pick up or drop off your child outside of the usual time, please contact our summer camp staff via email at education@leightoncentre.org or by phone 403-931-3636.
- Illness/sickness? Please do not send your child to camp with any cold or flu symptoms. If your child becomes sick while at camp, we will contact you to pick them up.
- How will you handle difficult behaviour? Our summer camp staff is well-trained to handle challenging behaviors. We enforce a 3-strike policy: if your child repeatedly breaks rules, disrespects personal space, or exhibits risky or disruptive behavior, you will be contacted to pick them up. They may return the next day if they follow the rules. However, if the behavior persists, we may ask you to keep them at home to prioritize the safety of all campers and staff.
- Accessibility needs: To ask about any special support or accommodations needed, please email at education@leightoncentre.org
- **Payment policy:** Payment in full is required at the time of registration.
- Benefits of becoming a Leighton Art Centre member For summer camp, members receive 10% off registration fees and the opportunity to for early registration (before the general public). Members also receive 10% off our Art & Nature workshops and purchases in our Gallery Shop, year-round. There are further perks for artists. Membership cost is \$50/year.
